Seedling Project

Watching God's Word Grow

What you will need:

Bible (your child's favorite Bible verse)

Plastic Cup/Marker

3-5 Seeds / Marigolds

1 cup of potting soil

Water (wet fingers and let the water drip from your tips to water your seeds)

Planting your seeds

Take your plastic cup and write your Bible verse on the cup. Take your potting soil and put it into your cup. Use your finger to poke a hole in the soil. Take a few seeds and put them in the hole. Sprinkle the seeds with potting soil making sure they are totally covered. Lightly sprinkle the soil with water, make sure that your soil is always damp.

Day one:

- 1. Ask your child what's their favorite Bible verse? Write the verse on the cup with a marker.
- 2. Plant seeds following instructions

Pray: Ask God to help us daily to remember His Word and to plant it in our hearts, minds and actions.

Day Two:

- 1. Read the Bible verse aloud
- 2. Ask your child/children how can we apply this verse today?
- 3. Sprinkle the soil with water
- 4. Share with your little one that when we read God's Word we are watering our hearts, minds and spirit with God's truth.

Pray: Ask God to help us daily to remember His Word and to apply it to our life

Day three:

- 1. Read the Bible verse aloud and talk about how they applied it the day before.
- 2. Sprinkle the soil with water
- 3. Talk about what is taking place under the soil and what takes place in your child's heart even though you can't see it.

Following days:

- 1. Read the Bible verse aloud and continue to apply it daily.
- 2. When the sprouts start to show, share with your child how God's Word will start to show in their lives as they continue to water it and pray.
